

Class I Rubbish Disposal Sites

Acceptable Wastes

- Construction and demolition debris, such as wood, metal, etc.
- Brick, mortar, concrete, stone and asphalt.
- Natural vegetation, such as tree limbs, stumps and leaves.
- Cardboard boxes.
- Appliances which have the motor removed, except those containing refrigerants.
- Furniture.
- Plastic, glass, crockery, and metal, except containers.
- Sawdust, wood shavings, and wood chips.
- Carpets or carpet backings generated from demolition or replacement.

Prohibited Wastes

- Any waste listed above contaminated by a possible pollutant, such as a food or chemical.
- Household garbage.
- Food or drink waste.
- Industrial waste, unless specifically approved the Office of Pollution Control.
- Liquids.
- Sludge.
- Contaminated soils.
- Paint or paint buckets.
- Oil and/or chemical containers.
- Any metal, glass, plastic, or paper container, unless specifically approved the Office of Pollution Control.
- Fabric.
- Paper wastes unless specifically approved by the Office of Pollution Control.
- Engines or motors.
- Refrigerators, unless specifically approved by the Office of Pollution Control.
- Whole tires.
- Cut or shredded tires, unless specifically approved by the Office of Pollution Control.
- Batteries.
- Toxic or hazardous waste.
- Asbestos and asbestos containing material.
- Medical waste.
- Electronic devices (computers, TV's, radios, stereos, etc.).
- Any other waste which may have an adverse effect on the environment.
