

ORDINANCE NO. 2004-1

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 1993-3
AS PREVIOUSLY AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. 2001-1
REGULATING THE COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL OF
SOLID WASTE AND ESTABLISHING THE CHARGES
AND ,FEES FOR USE OF THE SOLID WASTE COLLECTION AND
DISPOSAL SYSTEM OF THE CITY OF STARKVILLE, MISSISSIPPI**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Starkville that Ordinance No. 1993-3 be amended to read as follows:

SECTION III.

- Q. All establishments are responsible for controlling offensive odors in steel containers through sanitizing and deodorizing if necessary. Directions for sanitizing/deodorizing may come through any authorized City official. In addition to the enforcement provisions of this ordinance, the City reserves the right to schedule and charge for additional weekly pickups if necessary in the City's sole determination.

SECTION VIII.

- Q. There is hereby fixed and levied against the citizens of the City of Starkville, Mississippi a garbage charge and fee as follows:
 - 1. Upon each family occupying a house, an apartment, or a mobile home as a residence within the City of Starkville, Mississippi, there is imposed a flat monthly charge of \$10.50
 - 2. Upon each commercial retail, wholesale establishment and store buildings including laundries, cafes, theaters, hotels, motels, barber shops, beauty shops, offices, and every kind of business establishment, including industrial establishments, there is imposed a minimum monthly charge of \$15.75.

SECTION IX. Repeal of Existing Policies

All existing policies in conflict with this ordinance amendment shall be and they are hereby repealed as of the effective date of this ordinance.

SECTION X. Validity

Be it further ordained that the invalidity of any section, clause, sentence, or provision of this ordinance amendment shall not affect the validity of any other part of this ordinance which can be given effect without such invalid part or parts.

SECTION XI. Effective Date

Be it further ordained that the provisions of this ordinance amendment shall be in full force and effect immediately after passage and publication based upon the immediate presentation of the public health and/or related good cause.

PUBLICATION

The Clerk is directed to cause this ordinance to be published one time in the Starkville Daily News.
